

NUMBER OF STUDENTS


The number of students who attended outing activity was 50. The students were of MBS 1st year 2019-2020 batches.

ABOUT LENYADRI CAVE

The current name "Lenyadri" literally means "mountain cave". It is derived from 'Lena' in <u>Marathi</u> meaning "cave" and 'adri' in <u>Sanskrit</u> meaning "mountain" or "stone". The name "Lenyadri" appears in the Hindu scripture <u>Ganesha Purana</u> as well as in a <u>Sthala Purana</u>, in association to the Ganesha legend. It is also called *Jeernapur* and *Lekhan parvat* ("Lekhan mountain").

The hill was once known as *Ganesh Pahar* ("Ganesha hill"). An ancient inscription calls the place *Kapichita* (*Kapichitta*). The caves are also known as *Ganesh Lena* or Ganesh Caves

We climbed all the stairs from down to top to visit the cave which took almost 2 hours, we then visited the caves and temples made in it the idols of god Ganesha in the dark Cave which is designed with attractive way.





ABOUT SHIVNERI FORT

It is the birth place of **CHHATRAPATI SHIVAJI MAHARAJ**. Shivneri is known to be a place of Buddhist dominion from the 1st century AD. Its caves, rock-cut architecture and water system indicate the presence of habitation since 1st century AD. Shivneri got its name as it was under the possession of the Yadavas of Devagiri. Chhatrapati <u>Shivaji Maharaj Bhosale</u> was born at the fort on 19 February 1630 (some accounts place it 1627), and spent his childhood there. Inside the fort is a small temple dedicated to the goddess Shivai Devi, after whom Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Bhonsale was named.

Shivneri is a hill fort having a triangular shape and has its entrance from the South-west side of the hill. Apart from the main gate there is an entrance to the fort from side called locally as *the chain gate*, where in one has to hold chains to climb up to the fort gate. The fort extends up to 1 mi (1.6 km) with seven spiral well-defended gates. There are mud walls all around the fort. Inside the fort, the major buildings are the prayer hall, a tomb and a mosque. There is an overhanging where executions took place. There are many gates structures protecting this fort. Mana Daravaja is one of the many gates of the fort.
