What is Patent ?

Patent is an <u>Intellectual property right relating to</u> <u>inventions</u>. It is an <u>exclusive and monopoly right</u> granted to the <u>inventor by the government</u> to use the patented invention for a <u>limited period of time (20</u> <u>Years)</u>, thus preventing others from making, using, importing or selling in exchange of full disclosure of

his invention.
