- 5 To provide information about the voting process and deadlines.

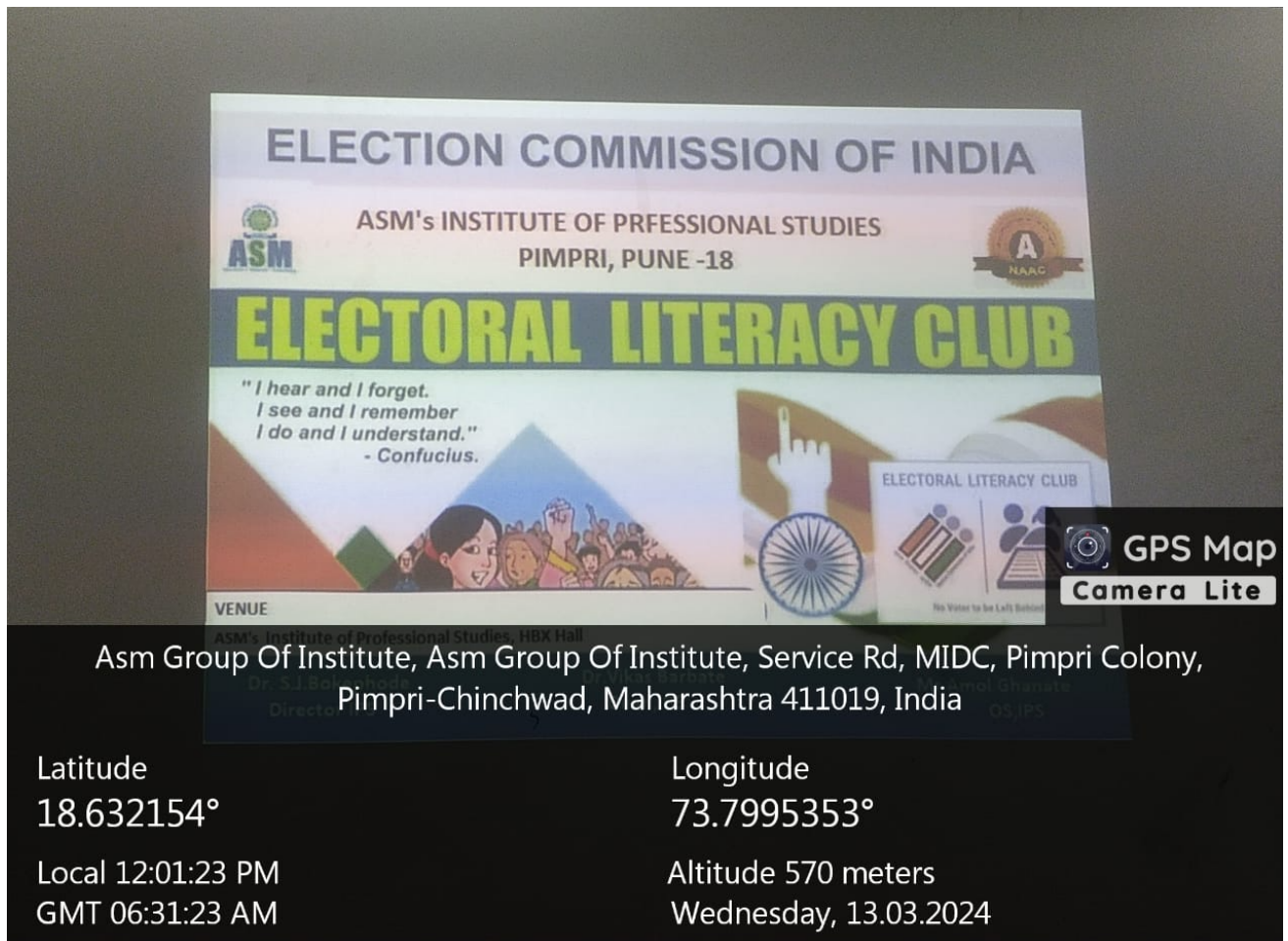
Speaker /Guest: Mr. Vikas Barbate

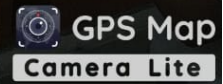
