### **Introduction:**

As per the Government of Maharashtra and Higher Education Department circular dated 23–24 December 2025, and in accordance with the directives of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Veer Bal Diwas was celebrated on 26 December 2025 in our institution. The celebration was organized to commemorate the supreme sacrifice, courage, and unparalleled bravery of Sahibzadas Baba Ajit Singh, Baba Jujhar Singh, Baba Zorawar Singh, and Baba Fateh Singh, the sons of Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji. Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi announced the observance of Veer Bal Diwas on 26 December every year on the occasion of Guru Gobind Singh Ji's Prakash Parv, with the objective of instilling values such as courage, sacrifice, righteousness, national integrity, moral values, and patriotism among children and youth.
