REPORT ON VAAVE ALUMNI PROGRAM

Introduction:

The Vaave Alumni Leadership Program workshop was organized at Symbiosis Learning Center, Lavhale, Pune, with the aim of strengthening alumni-institution relations through the use of digital platforms. The session was facilitated by Mr. Prasad Masade and attended by esteemed faculty members and representatives from various educational institutes across Pune and Maharashtra. Alumni engagement plays a significant role in the growth of any institution, as it connects the past with the present and builds a foundation for future progress. The workshop primarily focused on exploring the Vaave platform as a structured, technology-driven solution for fostering meaningful connections between alumni, students, and institutions.

Report:

The workshop began with an opening session where attendees introduced themselves and shared their expectations from the program. The discussions centered on strengthening alumni connections and building a culture of mutual growth between institutions and their alumni.

The facilitator, Mr. Prasad Masade, presented Vaave as a comprehensive online alumni engagement platform designed to bring together alumni, faculty, and students on a single digital interface. He explained its features such as maintaining alumni databases, facilitating alumni-student interactions, organizing reunions, webinars, and events, showcasing alumni achievements, and creating fundraising opportunities. The participants actively engaged in discussions, sharing the challenges faced in sustaining alumni connections over the long term. Faculty members pointed out difficulties in tracking alumni progress and maintaining updated records. Solutions were then proposed using the tools provided by Vaave to simplify these processes. Key highlights of the session included the recognition of alumni as an invaluable resource for academic and professional development. The facilitator emphasized how alumni could serve as mentors to students, act as recruiters for campus placements, and contribute to institutional recognition and development. An interactive discussion followed, where ideas were

exchanged on how both institutions and alumni could mutually benefit from stronger engagement. While alumni gain networking opportunities and visibility, institutions receive guidance, support, and enhanced reputation through their success stories. The workshop concluded with the facilitator stressing the importance of building a culture of continuous alumni engagement rather than one-time events. He provided insights into the next steps for adopting Vaave and integrating it with day-to-day institutional activities.
